

10 Questions for readers – A Blue Ridge Morning

It is important for me to know where there may be problems in the script, so please be as specific and detailed as possible when answering these questions. I'm interested in hearing what you found appealing, or not, and what may slow the story or isn't believable, etc.

1. Approximately how long did it take you to read the entire script?
2. Were you able to visualize the characters and locations in your mind?
3. Did the story seem smooth and seamless? Were there any missing transitions between scenes, or did anything seem out of order? Did the sense of time and timing work, or was there anything confusing about the time-space continuum?
4. Were there any holes in the story? Were you left with questions about any of the characters or the story? Was there anything that made you think 'no way, that's ridiculous!' Was there any dialogue, scenes, or relationships that you did not believe?
5. Were there surprising incidents in the story that you did not expect? What were they?
6. Did any of the characters, locations, and or circumstances sound familiar? If so, what were they?
7. Did this story remind you of another short story, book, movie etc? If so, what was it?
8. Who was your favorite character, and why?
9. Was there a favorite scene?
10. What actors and actresses can you imagine doing the following characters:
 - Charlie
 - C.F.
 - Pop Pop
 - Zelda
 - Chloe
 - Chloe's Grandmother
 - Sheriff Clatterbuck
 - The land developers (McDonald & Ashmore)
 - Curtis
